Forest Baseball club has teams from Under 7s all the way through to adults (Men and Women). We cater for all abilities accommodating ages 4 and up.

## Summer Competition details:

- Season dates: mid-September through March (break mid-Dec to mid-Jan). Exact dates to be confirmed.
- Home venue: Aquatic Reserve Baseball Park, Frenchs Forest  
Most clubs have Aquatic as their home ground in the summer comp however there may be some travel depending on what grade and the competition/association your team is registered with.
- Game times: Saturdays at 1pm and 3.30pm
- Game duration: 2 hours
- Fees: are \$285, which includes the annual Baseball Australia and Baseball NSW capitation and insurance charges which carry over into winter season. This means if you play winter as well, your fees for that competition will be much less.
- Uniform costs: Provided below.
- Equipment needed: You would just need to supply your own baseball glove and cleats (soccer boots for example are fine too).
- Grades: Summer baseball historically has two grades while Winter baseball has four grades.
