

## General club information

Forest Baseball club has teams from Under 7s all the way through to adults (Men and Women). We cater for all abilities accommodating ages 4 and up.

## Winter Competition details:

Winter baseball with Forest allows you to find the grade that suits your skills and experience.

- **Grades:** At least 4 grades are offered in Winter baseball. Grades 1 and 2 are jointly hosted by the Pacific Coast Baseball League (PCBL) Manly Warringah Minor League (MWML) with Grades 3 and 4 hosted by MWML.
- **Season dates:** April through August. Exact dates to be confirmed.
- **Home venue:** Aquatic Reserve Baseball Park, Frenchs Forest.  
1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade away games held at other fields in the greater Sydney region (e.g. Flat Rock, Rofe Park).  
3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Grade games held at Aquatic, Rat Park, Warriewood and Abbott Road, Curl Curl.
- **Game times:**  
1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade games – Usually Saturday at 12.30pm or 2.45pm  
3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Grade games – Saturday or Sunday at 12pm or 2.30pm
- **Game duration:** 2 hours
- **Fees:** are  
**Winter only player - \$285**, which includes the annual Baseball Australia and Baseball NSW capitation and insurance charges paid once a year.  
**Played Summer or Masters 2019/20 – \$170** (as annual capitation fees already paid).  
Note – There is also an optional \$50 fee or in lieu a request to volunteer 2 hours during the season.
- **Uniform costs:** Provided below.
- **Equipment needed:** You would just need to supply your own baseball glove and cleats (soccer boots for example are fine too).
