

**General club information**

Forest Baseball club has teams from Under 7s all the way through to adults (men and women). We cater for all abilities accommodating ages 4 and up.

**Summer Competition details:**

Summer baseball with Forest allows you to find the grade that suits your skills and experience. You must be at least 15 years old when the season starts, to be eligible to play.

- **Grades:** Three (3) grades are provided in our local summer competition which is entirely hosted by Manly-Warringah Minor League through the Manly-Warringah District Baseball Association.
- **Season dates:** Mid-November through late March. Exact dates to be confirmed.
- **Home venue:** The majority of games are played at Aquatic Reserve Baseball Park, Frenchs Forest. A small number of games are also held at Rat Park, Warriewood.
- **Game times:** Saturdays at 1.30pm and 4pm. Some Sunday games may also be played at 1.30pm and 4pm.
- **Game duration:** 2 hours
- **Fees:** \$365, which includes the annual Baseball Australia and Baseball NSW capitation and insurance charges paid once a year (\$125), Manly Association fees (\$120), umpiring fees (\$70), platform registration fee (\$12) and Forest fee (\$38).
- **Equipment needed:** You would just need to supply your own baseball glove and cleats (soccer boots for example are fine too).
- **Uniform costs:** Provided below.

We are a very social (yet competitive) league, where after games BBQs & drinks are as important to us the game itself, so there is no pressure to do anything other than enjoy yourself.
