

Summer baseball with Forest BC allows you to find the team that suits your skills and experience. You must be born on or before August 31, 2010 to be eligible to play. We play in the Manly Minor League competition.

- **Grades:** Depending on team numbers, up to 3 grades are offered in Summer baseball, with Forest featuring teams in every grade.  
 1<sup>st</sup> grade is for experienced players whereas 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> grade has a mix of experience, abilities and ages.  
 3<sup>rd</sup> grade is ideal for first time players.
- **Season dates:** 21st September through to end of March, with a 6 week break over the Christmas/NY period, in line with school holidays.
- **Home venue:** Aquatic Reserve Baseball Park at Frenchs Forest and Rat Park and Boondah Reserve in Warriewood.
- **Game times:** Predominantly Saturdays but due to limited ground availability **we will also have Sunday games this season**. Games start at 1.30pm or 4pm and last for 2 hours.  
 Post-game “analysis” (ie. bragging & drinks) can easily last that long again 😊
- **Fees:** \$380, which includes the annual Baseball Australia and Baseball NSW capitation and insurance charges paid once a year (\$137), Manly Association fees (\$95), Forest Club fee (\$40), Ground Infrastructure Levy (\$25) as well as a GameDay portal levy (\$13) and all umpiring charges (\$70).
- **Equipment needed:** You just need to supply your own baseball glove and cleats (soccer boots, for example, are also ok).
